AXV – The Final Programme

THIS VERSION REALLY IS THE FINAL PROGRAMME

This document sets out the Ministry of Steampunk's plans for the forthcoming *Weekend at the Asylum* Steampunk Festival to be held in the Historic Quarter of Lincoln in August 2025 from the Opening Ceremony on Friday 22 August through to the Closing Ceremony on Monday 25 August.

The document has been prepared with minimal formatting and no photos in order to keep the file size low and make access to the document easier. It is not meant to be beautiful but simply informative; look up from the page or your screen and the beauty of Asylum will be all around you.

There are only a few small changes from the version of this document released on 1 August¹

This document should be read alongside the event planner which is available separately and which gives an overview of what is happening when and where.

With a host of features taking place at the same time and in so many locations, many people will face difficult decisions over what they can attend. We are sorry if we have put two of your favourite features on at the same time. We know we can't please all of the people all of the time, but we try our best to get as close as we can.

We have some very special new features this year but have also retained many long-time favourite features of Asylum. We hope you enjoy the mixture of old and new.

As well as the timed features there are many other things that you can dip in and out of as time allows, including the Clockwork and Gaderian Quests, Where's Wally, the Old Curiosity Swap, spotting the Blue Plaques in local businesses, the Collect-15 game and so on. Some of these features have been allocated a time and a place where you can be sure to meet with the organiser, just because otherwise it can be really hard to find someone at an event amongst so many people.

We have added more content suitable for children this year; they are the steampunks of the future and we want to do all that we can to make Asylum a friendly place to be for all ages.

There are also a number of crafting workshops. Most will have limited capacity. If you or your children would like to attend, then where possible we suggest you try to make contact with the organiser in advance; in most cases we have listed where you will find them in the listing below.

A feature on Steampunk and Burlesque with Scarlet Butterfly has been added at 16:00 on Saturday in Westgate and a feature on Alchemy, the Steampunk Musical, has been added at 14:00 on Sunday in the AR ballroom. Two performances of Steampunk Poetry have been added on Sunday at 14:00 and Monday at 13:30, both in St Paul in the Bail. Steambards will be meeting in the castle grounds on Monday at 14:00

Another change this year is that we have increased our efforts to raise money for charity, particularly with the inclusion of the Performer's Auction and the collection during the Grand Promenade. Other smaller features like the fabric swap and repair station will also be making charity collections; please do support them where you can.

The Kings Lynn Steampunk Society (KLSS) will be manning a free repair stand in the Heritage Centre on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Many who attend Asylum put an enormous amount of work into their costumes and accessories but even so, disaster can strike when it is least convenient. Something breaks, stitches pop or fastenings fail to fasten. If such a misfortune visits you during Asylum, come along to the repair stand where you will have access to tools, equipment, materials and assistance to get you back into gear and out enjoying the events again.

There will be a number of large exhibits in the castle grounds where this year you will also find the Asylum Tea Tent which will be a place for wristband holders to rest their feet while drinking tea and enjoying a bite to eat. There will also be food traders in the castle and at Westgate Academy.

11:30 Asylum Fashion Retrospective | AR Ballroom

Join Lady Elsie for a celebration of Asylum fashions from 2009 to the present day. Please be warned – there will be frocks.

12:00 Teapot Racing Virgins | Westgate Playground

An event for the teapot-curious, a fun activity to see how you get on steering a teapot around a course. Who knows, it might inspire you to take part in one of the teapot racing competitions over the weekend? No previous experience required.

12:30 The Guild of Occult Steam Sciences | AR Ballroom

It needs help sorting through the clues to uncover and perhaps even stop a dire mystery that threatens London, the Empire, and even next Tuesday's big village cricket match. 14:30 The Old Curiosity Swap | Westgate Playground

The 'OCS' is an opportunity for participants to swap trinkets, badges, patches or other items. No money must exchange hands; this is purely for swapping items. You can take part in this fun activity any time over the weekend – we just put a few 'meets' on the programme to make it easier to find like-minded people.

14:30 The Great Exhibition | Heritage Centre

The Great Exhibition will be located in the Heritage Centre at AXV. Please bring along any entries from 14:30 on Friday or from 10:00 on Saturday morning. There's lots of information about the Great Exhibition including eligibility criteria on the MoS website.

15:00 The 3 'o' Clock Tea Bell | Everywhere

The 3 o'clock' bell is such a pivotal part of English culture that it doesn't really require any explanation.

15:00 Teapot Racing | Westgate Playground

Bring your own racing teapot along or try one of the 'house' teapots in this adrenaline fuelled sport. With tea as one of the main themes of AXV what could be a more natural pastime than steering a motorised teapot around an obstacle course?

15:00 A Guided Tour of The Imaginarium | Westgate School

Join creator Gary Nicholls to explore some of the pictures he has on display. Find out more about the stories behind the pictures as well as the story in the book and also find out what is happening with The Imaginarium next.

15:30 Afternoon Tea with Steam Powered Giraffe | AR Edwardian Suite

Please note that wristbands alone do not give access to the afternoon tea parties which require a separate ticket. Tickets are available in advance only (subject to availability) and cannot be purchased on the day.

Join Steam Powered Giraffe for a tea party to remember forever. You will have an opportunity to meet with the band members as they visit each of the tables in the Edwardian Suite. Please note the band will not be in costume or makeup for this feature – so it is an opportunity for you to meet the people behind the robots. If you are attending this event, you will have received full information direct from the Assembly Rooms.

15:30 What's That Gadget? | AR Ballroom

Few things spark more excitement in the world of steampunk than new gadgets. Bring yours along and share a word or two about it. Tell us how you made it from an old badminton racquet and a box of rusty screws and in turn marvel at everyone else's creations.

16:00 Asylum Art Project | AR Ballroom

Come along and find out more about the special Asylum Community Art Project. Collect a small canvas (or bring your own – ideally 5 inches square) and decorate it to show what the Asylum means to you. The completed panels will be assembled into a joint artwork at the end of Asylum.

16:00 Decodance Workshop | Westgate Academy

Join Lady Elsie to learn a simple dance or two which you can try out at the DecoDance tomorrow night. You don't need previous dancing experience or a partner, but comfortable shoes are highly recommended.

16:30 Asylum Virgins Meet | AR Ballroom

Is this your first visit to the wonderful alternative reality of Asylum? If it is, then come along and hear from Major Tinker, joint founder of the original event in 2009. John will give you some tips on how to make the most of the time you have available.

10:00 The Illicit Market | AR [Assembly Rooms] Ballroom

The illicit market is a combination of role playing and small-time peddling of wares of many shapes and sizes. This is a very popular feature at Asylum, and you will find out more about it under the 'Features' tab on the MoS website.

10:00 Embroidery Workshop | Heritage Centre Classroom

Discover the traditional technique of Crewelwork with Amy Turner's beginner friendly taster session, whether you are new to embroidery, or are wanting to learn a new skill. This introductory workshop will last up to 1.5 hours, during which you will learn 5 stitches to create a design inspired by traditional Jacobean Crewelwork.

Minimum age 10 and children must be accompanied by an adult.

10:00 The Great Exhibition | Heritage Centre

The Great Exhibition is a must-see for everyone coming to Asylum and this year will have its own stamp for your 'Collect XV' game so you can prove you visited!

10:00 Ticket collection for SPG Q&A session | Castle Merch Gazebo

If you have a festival wristband (for Saturday or the full weekend) and would like to see Steam Powered Giraffe in their Q&A session at the County Assembly Rooms today you will need to pick up a free ticket in person from the Merch Gazebo in the castle, near to the courthouse (the building ahead of you when you enter through the East Gate). Strictly one ticket per person. If you manage to bag a ticket you will be in for a treat as SPG will be in full makeup and costume and will be performing a short acoustic set during the session.

10:30 Belly Fusion Dance Collective | Westgate Academy Playground

Guaranteed to bring a smile to your faces and to lighten your mood, the wonderful and graceful ladies of Belly Fusion Dance Collective will perform a selection of dances with their trademark poise and synchronicity.

10:30 Box Set | Castle Bandstand

Box Set will be opening the Airship Pirates evening gig with Abney Park on Friday night. We are thrilled that they have agreed to stay around a while on Saturday morning to do a short set on the castle Bandstand. It will only be a matter of time before they are invited to play at more Steampunk events.

10:30 The Horseshoe Game | Caravan in the Castle

A fun western-themed activity for children. Come along to the painted time-travel caravan in the castle where you will find Tara and Ali who will tell you what it's all about...

11:00 Asylum Tea Duelling | AR Ballroom

Another favourite tea-related activity involving malted milk biscuits and nerves of steel. Come along and watch the Tiffin Mistress put contestants through their paces. You could even take part yourself and in doing so become the Asylum champion.

11:00 Beyond The Dawn | Westgate Academy Playground

A new musical project by Jane Clarity of Simply Kate Bush combining new Steampunk music with prog, pop and elven rock with a strong message of hope and restoration.

11:00 The Far Tea Challenge | Westgate Academy

The aim of this challenge is to see from how far away participants can get a teabag to land in a teacup. Standard class competitors will be tasked with throwing or otherwise propelling a standard dry unmodified teabag into a cup using nothing but their own strength and dexterity.

Open class competitors will be encouraged to use whatever gadgets and contraptions that they wish to bring along to get the teabag into the cup, and furthermore they can modify the teabag however they wish.

But there's a catch. Each competitor will only have one minute to set up their contraptions and modify their teabags. If you exceed the time limit, then the round will be forfeit.

11:00 Jetpack, Para and Wacky Racers | Castle Banjo

Some of the most quintessentially bonkers and 'pure unadulterated steampunk' features of Asylum are the jetpack race, para-racers and the wacky race.

Come and put your jetpack through its paces alongside other crazy inventors and see who takes home the Asylum jetpack medal for AXV. Once again, I am afraid the use of Unobtainium-15 as fuel is banned.

As for the wacky race, this really is your opportunity to see some highly wacky racers take part in a race along the castle banjo. Some will be powered by dubious means whilst others will be piloted by dubious pilots. There could be hobby horses. Some will finish the course, but quite possibly not all of them. The winner will receive a medal.

And then there's the para-racers' race. Contrary to what you might think, speed is a positive hindrance in the para-race which is all about style, creativity and entertainment. Because this is Asylum.

11:00 Box Set Meet & Merch | Castle Merch Gazebo

You heard them play either at the Airship Pirates gig at the Engine Shed on Friday evening or just now on the castle bandstand. Now is your chance to pick up some merch from George and Tony of Box Set.

11:30 Photo session with Steam Powered Giraffe | AR Edwardian Suite

Please note you will require a Saturday or weekend festival wristband as well as a ticket to access this feature. If there are still tickets available on the day you will be able to purchase them from Event Control in Castle Square.

This is your opportunity to have a professionally taken photograph with Steam Powered Giraffe who will be in full costume and makeup. You will get to pose with the musicians and will have a hard copy photo to take away with you.

11:30 Steam Western Meet | Heritage Centre Outside

Come and say howdy to your steampunk western chums as tension builds towards the High Noon Shoot Out. There may be few survivors, so this is a good time to exchange some choice last words or seek forgiveness for past misdemeanours.

11:30 Peg Doll Workshop | Heritage Centre Classroom

Create a 'mini-me' Asylum XV Steampunk Peg Doll bag charm or badge to wear and love! The workshop will be led by artist Rachel Duffiend and everything you need will be provided.

Suitable for ages 10 or over (under 13s need to be accompanied by an adult).

Numbers are limited so it would be best to see Rachel who you will find as Lady Dorienne Gray in the castle Tea Tent to book a place.

11:30 Captain Kuppa-T and the Zeppelin Crew | Castle Bandstand

You can't have too many cups of tea, and you can't listen to Captain Kupp-T and the Zeppelin Crew too much either. After entertaining the audience at the Advance Guard on Thursday night, by Saturday morning they will brewing up for another top-notch acapella performance combining fabulous lyrics and impeccable close harmony singing.

12:00 Q&A session with Victor and the Bully and Alice Strange | AR Ballroom

Victor and the Bully and Alice Strange are without doubt two of the most popular performers in the UK Steampunk scene. Come along and see them in conversation and answering questions from the audience.

12:00 Belly Fusion Dance Collective – Dance Workshop | Westgate Academy

This is your opportunity to come and meet the ladies of Belly Fusion Dance Collective and take part in a workshop to try out some of their moves. No former belly dancing experience is required!

12:00 High Noon Shoot-Out | Heritage Centre Outside

Please note that for insurance purposes you must be a wristband holder and must be aged 18 or over to take part in this feature.

Some steampunks duel with cups of tea and others with parasols, but there are still a few who are brave enough to fire nerf darts at each other (note the absence of the word straight) in this high-octane celebration of sharp(ish) shooting. Do you have what it takes to emerge the victor?

12:00 Minimum Altitude Display Team | Castle Banjo

The MA.D.T.s (Minimum Altitude Display Team) are excited to be returning once more to put on their unique interpretation of the finest in daring do. In the finest traditions of the Red Arrows and satirical excellence the M.A.D.T.s are prepared, once more, to put life, limb and sanity on the line. Don't try it at home.

12:00 Kuppa-T & the Zeppelin Crew Meet & Merch | Castle Merch Gazebo

Come and find Captain Kuppa-T and his Zeppelin Crew for a chat and to bag yourself some merch after their Bandstand performance.

12:30 The Steampunk Sallys | St Paul in the Bail

Under the masterful direction of General Anna Bollick, the other Annas (yes all of them are called Anna) will regale you with words of redemption and uplifting songs all designed to persuade you to give up the demon drink (and most of life's other pleasures).

12:30 Meet The Makers | Heritage Centre Classroom

Come and meet Grahame Jebb and his maker friends. Talk tinkering, bodging, fixing and any number of other 'making' verbs. Audience participation will be positively encouraged.

This session will be a safe space for people who like to talk about making things out of other things and want to meet other people who have been doing so for even longer.

12:30 Kitten Von Mew | Castle Bandstand

Ahead of her performance at the Decodance tonight, Kitten will be treating us to a set on the castle Bandstand. 40's pinup, fabulous songstress and all round superstar. Make sure you catch her performance.

12:30 Dr Who Meet-up | In front of the Castle Marquees

Set your TARDIS controls to 12:30 in front of the Castle Marquees in Lincoln Castle on Saturday 23 August 2025 and you might just bump into some other like-minded two-hearted people.

13:00 Unaccompanied Group Singing | Westgate Academy

Come along to the Westgate Academy to try a feature that was very popular at Asylum last year – an unaccompanied singing workshop with Sarah Sim.

13:00 Meet the Droids | Heritage Centre Outside

R2-SP (Steampunk R2-D2 from Star Wars) and his friends are always hugely popular at steampunk events, loved by children of all ages. Come along to the carpark area outside the Heritage Centre (you can bring a parent with you – they will love it too) and you can be sure to get to see R2-SP and his friends up close.

13:00 Dr Who Meetup | Castle Banjo

The Steampunk Dr Who group have been meeting in the shadows the last few years, so we thought it was time to allow them out in the open for AXV. We've told them the castle is bigger on the inside. Come and meet them and find out what makes them tick.

13:00 Kitten Von Mew Meet & Merch | Castle Merch Gazebo

Kitten will be available to chat and sell you some of her fab merch following on from her castle bandstand performance.

13:30 Q&A session with Steam Powered Giraffe | AR Ballroom

Please note that this feature is free to access to anyone who (a) has a festival wristband (Saturday or weekend) and (b) has collected a Q&A ticket from the Merch Tent in the castle on Saturday morning. The tickets will be given out on a first-comefirst-served basis. Once everyone with a ticket has been given a chance to enter the Ballroom and further capacity will be available to a stand-by queue of wristband holders.

SPG will be in full costume and makeup for this feature in which they will not only ask questions from the chair and the audience, but they will also play a short acoustic set. If you are an SPG fan you will definitely want to be at this feature.

13:30 The Old Curiosity Swap | St Paul in the Bail

Meet up here and now with like-minded folk and swap stuff. It's an addictive pastime and you may just go home with an enviable collection of treasures.

13:30 Belly Fusion Dance Collective | Castle Banjo

Our favourite Belly Dance Troupe are back again with their signature synchronous moves, elegance and smiles. Don't try and stand still while they are performing – you won't be able to.

13:30 Victor and the Bully Meet and Merch | Castle Merch Gazebo

Following on from their Q&A session at the Assembly Rooms you will have an opportunity to chat and buy some merch from the band over in the Merch Gazebo.

14:00 Missed Any Steampunk Comics Lately? | Westgate Academy

Attack on Titan, Gotham by Gaslight, Lady Mechanika, Grandville, The League of Extraordinary Gentleman...there are probably more steampunk flavoured comics & graphic novels out there than you realise. In this informal talk, comics creators David Morris (Norton, Baker Street Irregulars) and Colin Mathieson (Curious Chancer, Zulu) will guide you through some of the amazing titles available and invite you to share your favourites and make some new discoveries!

14:00 Teapot Racing | Heritage Centre Outside

Roll up, roll up. It's time to sharpen your wits and compete to avoid the tea cosy of doom and if possible, to achieve the fastest time around the course. There will be medals for each 'teapot racing' session and an MoS medal for the fastest time over the weekend.

14:00 Beyond The Dawn | Castle Bandstand

Last year Jane Clarity performed on the Bandstand as Simply Kate Bush. This year she is back with a new elven-themed style as Beyond The Dawn. Expect tales of time travel, other dimensions, inventions and astro extensions.

14:00 Fairytale Meet-up | In front of the Castle Marquees

If you've been to any of the MoS steampunk fairytale weekends at Belvoir, Tutbury or Butterley this meet-up is for you. Come as a fairy, elf or any other magical or mystery creature whether good or evil.

14:30 Play the Tambourine with the Steampunk Sallys | Westgate Playground

If you want to learn to play the tambourine the Steampunk Sally's way this workshop is for you. It is a great fun activity and of course The General is the perfect teacher. The Sallys tried this for the first time at Blists Hill recently and it was hilarious.

14:30 Fairytale Meetup | Castle Banjo

This is the time for the fairies and other fae folk (and monsters) to make their way to the castle Banjo to chat to the gathering crowds. Expect magic and wings and weird and wonderful.

14:30 Beyond the Dawn Meet & Merch | Castle Merch Gazebo

Come and catch up with Jane Clarity after her performance as Beyond The Dawn on the castle bandstand. Ask about her love of Tolkien and buy some merch!

15:00 The 3 'o' Clock Tea Bell | Everywhere

See explanation on Friday.

15:00 Q&A session with Abney Park | AR Ballroom

Abney Park will also been in their stage costumes for this question-and-answer session which will also include a discussion of the wider lore of Abney Park including the books, games and other creations – the life's work of the brilliant Robert Brown.

15:00 Kittysugar Powertex Workshop | Heritage Centre

Participants will explore Powertex fabric hardener to create a dimensional steampunk-inspired medal or brooch, learning fabric sculpting, texture building, and layering with metallic effects.

15:00 Virtual Cricket | Heritage Centre Outside

The cricket match at Asylum XIV last year proved beyond any reasonable doubt that the ball in a game of cricket is entirely superfluous. Come and watch the game again this year, see the (imaginary) ball fly, hear the (imaginary) 'thwack' of leather on willow and marvel at the team's ability to distil the essence of this finest of game to the enthralled crowd.

15:00 Steam Powered Giraffe Meet and Merch | Heritage Centre Classroom

Please note this session is separately ticketed. You will need both a wristband and a ticket to participate. Tickets are available through the MoS website. Subject to capacity there might be a few more tickets available from Event Control but at the time of writing this cannot be confirmed.

SPG love to meet their fans, and their fans love to meet them. This session fulfils both desires. SPG will be in full costume and makeup. You will be able to buy merch, have something signed, meet the band and take a quick selfie.

15:00 Meet the Great Exhibition Makers | Heritage Centre

The Great Exhibition is judged blind, and no names are on display – so nobody knows who made what. In 2024 we started this feature which is an opportunity for those who have entries in the exhibition to come and meet up with each other and talk about their creations. You don't have to be a maker to take part – all are welcome. Come and meet the people behind all the amazing creations on display.

15:00 PlayTaiko Performance | Castle Bandstand/Banjo

PlayTaiko bring you an exhibition of the vibrant and powerful art of Japanese Taiko Drumming. Intricate choreography binds together sounds ranging from earth shaking rhythm to the gentle flute. You can find out more at www.playtaiko.com

15:00 Panning for Gold | Caravan in the Castle

Another western-themed children's activity. Come along and learn how to pan for gold with Tara and Ali – you will find them near the painted time-travel caravan in the castle grounds.

15:30 The Clockwork Quest | St Paul in the Bail

Come and find the quest-giver – either to be given your quest, or to hand it back in. This was a hugely popular feature at Asylum XIV, and we are delighted the quest-giver is coming back to do it all again at AXV. Check out 'Clockwork Quest' on Facebook for more information.

16:00 Steampunk & Burlesque: what's the connection? | Westgate Academy

Have you ever wondered why steampunks love burlesque so much? Come along to listen to Scarlet Butterfly in conversation with Gary Nicholls about the creative artistry of burlesque and its connections to steampunk.

Please note that this feature may not be suitable for children.

16:00 Steam Heart Film Presentation | AR Edwardian Suite

Professor Terry Martin Mace retired from professional academic life to work on a trilogy of neo-steampunk films. Join the professor for the premiere of one of these films and to hear about the creative process behind them.

16:00 Gaderian Quests | Westgate Playground
