

THE SPOOF BLUE PLAQUE SCHEME 2024 v3

This is the **THIRD** version of this document, created on 22 August and it replaces the one created on 21 August 2024

In 2023 we put up a number of spoof Blue Plaques in shop windows and on walls in and around the Historic Quarter. We made them into a trail which you could follow for fun.

This year we are using the Blue Plaques differently. We asked a number of businesses in the area if they would host a Blue Plaque in exchange for offering a 'Little Something' to wristband holders.

Lots of businesses have responded positively and the list below is correct at the date at the top of this page. It may be updated closer to the start of the event – so do check the Ministry of Steampunk Website to be sure you have the latest version to hand.
